Minutes of Meeting Held January 8, 2015

Notice of the time, date, location and agenda of this meeting to the extent then known, was duly published at least forty-eight hours in advance of this meeting, by posting on the official bulletin board and by publications in the official newspapers of the Board. This meeting is being conducted in accordance with the terms and provisions of the "Open Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey

<u>Call to Order</u> - The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jack Bollentin at 8:06 pm. "Open Meetings Act" statement was read by Board Attorney Youssouf. Commissioners Bollentin, Leonard, Sherry and Torres were present. Commissioners Ruditsky was absent. Board Attorney Youssouf was also present. All participated in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Minutes – Three corrections to the minutes of the December 11 2015 meeting were noted: Fire Bureau, p1, change "#5405" to "#5404"; Old Business, b. Renovations at Station #2, change "Commissioner Sherry" to "Commissioner Bollentin"; Legal Report, last line, change "Commissioners Bollentin and Leonard" to "Commissioners Bollentin and Sherry". Commissioner Sherry motioned to approve the minutes of the December 11, 2014 General Meeting as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Leonard. Motion passed by majority vote with Commissioner Torres abstaining due to his absence.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> –The report and bill list (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference) as of January 8, 2015 was read by Commissioner Torres. Commissioner Leonard motioned to pay the bills as presented, seconded by Commissioner Sherry. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Legal Report - Board Attorney Youssouf read a Resolution adopting a budget for calendar year January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015. Commissioner Torres motioned to accept the Resolution, seconded by Commissioner Bollentin opened up the meeting for a Commissioner Sherry. hearing for the purpose of comments/discussion on the budget. Board Attorney Youssof provided a brief overview of the budget to the public. comments/discussion from the public, Commissioner Torres motioned to close the hearing, seconded by Commissioner Sherry. Motion to close the hearing passed by unanimous consent. Vote to accept the Resolution to adopt the budget from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 passed by unanimous consent (Ayes: Bollentin, Leonard, Sherry, Torres; Nays: none: Absent: Board Attorney Youssouf will advertise the Ruditsky: Abstentions: none). adopted budget. He reminded all that the elections will be on February 21, 2015 from 2 pm to 9 pm. Lt. Reynolds was directed to contact the two poll workers. Board Attorney Youssouf has received two nominating petitions (Bollentin and Documents that require Budget documents were signed. Commissioner Ruditsky's signature will be held until he is available to sign them. Renovations at Station #2: Commissioner Bollentin asked if a dollar amount for the project is to be included on the ballot. Board Attorney Youssouf advised that there needs to be an amount "not to exceed" included in the Bond Referendum. After discussion and information regarding the process was presented to the Board by Board Attorney Youssouf, he recommended a special election in June.

Truck & Building/Career Department Report – read by Commissioner Sherry (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference). Commissioner Bollentin directed Lt. Reynolds to pick up 30 9-volt batteries – FF Leonard reported that he already has them. All pass alarms to be changed. Tires needed on #5444 – truck recently spun out in the snow. Commissioner Torres motioned to approve the purchase of new tires for #5444, seconded by Commissioner Sherry. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

<u>Chief's Report</u> – Report to be given later in the meeting. (Due to a fire call later in the meeting, Chief was not available to give his report.)

<u>President's Report</u> – absent/out sick. Nothing new to report. Commissioner Bollentin requested that the current Rules and Regulations be followed. Financial Report: expenses are to be included and submitted to the Board quarterly. Commissioner Bollentin advised that the Board is open to working with the fire company and if there is anything that you need to let the Board know.

Fire Bureau: Report (part of the aforementioned Career Department Report) reviewed by Fire Fighter Burmeister with the Board. Basso was injured recently. Commissioner Bollentin has the report. Trailer fire was determined accidental due to pipe tape wiring. FF Burmeister reported that there is an investigating class that he is interested in taking. Commissioner Sherry motioned to approve attendance at the class at a cost not to exceed \$300, seconded by Commissioner Leonard. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Work Orders: on computer. Commissioner Bollentin reported that he reviewed them all recently.
