### Minutes of Meeting Held December 10, 2015

Notice of the time, date, location and agenda of this meeting to the extent then known, was duly published at least forty-eight hours in advance of this meeting, by posting on the official bulletin board and by publications in the official newspapers of the Board. This meeting is being conducted in accordance with the terms and provisions of the "Open Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey

<u>Call to Order</u>- The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jack Bollentin at 8:00 pm. "Open Meetings Act" statement was read by Board Attorney Youssouf. All participated in the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed.

Roll Call: Commissioners Bollentin, Goldman, Leonard and Torres were present. Commissioner Ruditsky was absent. Board Attorney Youssouf was also present. Board Attorney Youssouf declared that there was a quorum.

Minutes: Commissioner Torres motioned to approve the minutes of the November 12, 2015 General meeting seconded by Commissioner Leonard. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Treasurer's Report – The report and bill list (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference) as of December 12, 2015 was read by Commissioner Torres. Commissioner Goldman motioned to pay the bills as presented, seconded by Commissioner Leonard. Commissioner Torres motioned to accept the treasurer's report as read, seconded by Commissioner Leonard. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

Legal Report - Board Attorney Youssouf referred Commissioners to their respective 2016 Budget Package, specifically Page 6 (Budget Resolution). Board Attorney read the 2016 Fire district Budget Resolution Township of Jackson Fire District No. 4 Budget Fiscal Year: January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016 (an executed copy is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference). Commissioner Leonard motioned to accept the Resolution as read, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion passed (4 ayes, one absent Ruditsky). Nominating petitions were given to the clerk. nominating petitions must be turned in 28 days prior to the election (due back by 1/22 or 1/25). After discussion it was determined that Cheryl will contact Board Attorney Youssouf on 1/25 or 1/26 to advise what nominating petitions had been received. Capital question to be included ballot (3 on renovation/expansion at Station #2). Notice to be posted ten days prior to election in ten public places. List must be made and maintained as to the ten places where the notice was posted. Board Attorney Youssouf confirmed with the Board that Station #2 is on property that is owned by the Board. Revised Banquet Hall Agreement was distributed to the Board (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference). Commissioner Torres motioned to accept a Resolution in Title for Line Item

Transfers in the amount of \$61,60000 from item over expended to line items under-expended, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion passed (4 yes – Commissioner Ruditsky – absent).

<u>Truck & Building/Career Department Report</u> – read by Commissioner Goldman (a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference). #05 is not repaired yet. Parts have been ordered. FF Leonard provided Board with a copy of notice for class on Jan 9 2016 requesting that four career firefighters attend the class (29<sup>th</sup> Annual Firefighter Safety Seminar, 1/9/16 at Saint Barnabas Medical Center, Livingston- a copy of which is attached to the original minutes and incorporated herein by reference). Board was in agreement that four career firefighters attend.

<u>Chief's Report</u>— Commissioner Bollentin reported that Santa Patrol should be finished up tonight. Barry MacNeil submitted a letter request to use his own helmet. Commissioner Torres motioned to approve Barry MacNeil using his own helmet, seconded by Commissioner Goldman. Motion passed by unanimous consent. Commissioner Goldman praised Fire Company for Santa Patrol.

<u>President's Report</u> – Commissioner Bollentin reported that the financial report for the year was received. \$ 41,987 was the total amount that was taken in.

# 2016 FIRE DISTRICT BUDGET RESOLUTION

### TOWNSHIP OF JACKSON

## FIRE DISTRICT NO. 4 BUDGET

FISCAL YEAR: January 1, 2016 to December 31, 2016

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget for the Township of Jackson Fire District No. 4 (the "Fire District") for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 has been presented before the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District at its open public meeting of December 10, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the budget as introduced is in compliance with the Property Tax Levy Cap Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.44 et. seq.) and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$1,567,931, which includes an amount to be raised by taxation of \$1,529,174, and Total Appropriations of \$1,567,931; and

WHEREAS, the amount to be raised by taxation to support the district budget shall be the amount to be certified to the assessor of the municipality to be assessed against the taxable property in the district, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14-79. Such amount shall be equal to the amount of the total appropriations set forth in the budget minus the total amount surplus and miscellaneous revenues set forth in the budget; and

WHEREAS, in calculating the amount to be raised by taxation, the Fire District has taken into account the assessed valuation of taxable property in the Fire District;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District, at an open public meeting held on December 10, 2015 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, of the Fire District for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the Fire District's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of the Fire District will consider the Annual Budget for adoption on January 14, 2016.
